INTRODUCTION

Orchids are the most evolved in the plant kingdom, these bear interesting, long lasting flowers with unmatched beauty and diverse shapes, sizes and colors. There are more than 1300 species in India, out of which 400 are endemic. They have always attracted the laymen, commercial growers, entrepreneurs and scientists. Floral diversity and long shelf life of their bewitchingly beautiful flowers, have contributed significantly to the development of international trade in cut-flowers and pot-plants. Many species of orchids have also been used in traditional system of medicine throughout the world for the treatment of various kinds of ailments. With the advancements in the conventional and biotechnological methods, the orchid based vocations are booming. But, due to lack of awareness, overexploitation and habitat destruction, these plants are becoming endangered. Therefore, for their conservation and sustainable development, there is an urgent need for, creating awareness about these important plants and assessing their biological status and importance and subsequently developing effective methods for their propagation.

The Orchid Society of India (TOSI) established in 1984 and registered under the Societies Registration Act with its Headquarters at Botany Department, Panjab University, Chandigarh aims at i) promoting awareness about scientific and commercial importance of orchids; ii) gathering and disseminating information on various aspects of orchidology; iii) projecting the importance of improvement and propagation of Indian Orchids. In order to fulfill these aims, the Society provides a common forum for exchange of ideas amongst the orchid scientists, growers and enthusiasts by organizing meetings, conferences, symposia, lectures, poster exhibition, orchid shows, painting competition regarding orchids, at regular intervals. The society is now organizing a three day "National Conference on Orchids Science and Commerce: Integration of Medicinal Orchids, Sustainable Development and Societal Benefits" jointly with and at School of Biotechnology, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi (SMVD) University, Kakyral, Katra (J&K), during February 13-15, 2015. An optional post-conference visit is also being planned to Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine/Patni Top/Local sightseeing (Jammu) on February 15, 2015

CONFERENCE

The Conference shall address itself to different aspects of Orchid diversity, assessment and taxonomy; Biology and ecology; propagation, Improvement, and conservation; Medicinal Importance, commercialization and societal benefits. Several leading orchid scientists, growers, entrepreneurs, enthusiasts, and policy planners are expected to participate and deliberate on the conference theme. Besides the Inaugural and Plenary sessions, it will comprise 4 technical sessions. Each technical session will have 1-2 Lead Lectures (20-25 min duration including 5 min for discussion), by invited speakers followed by some contributed papers (10-15 min duration). Facilities of overhead and LCD projectors shall be available. The contributed papers shall be selected on merit and some of these will be allocated to poster session, which shall be a major attraction of the conference. For each poster presentation, 1m² area shall be made available. The outstanding posters shall be awarded. The abstracts of the lectures and accepted papers will be made available during the conference and the full papers shall be published in the conference proceedings/special volume of *J. Orchid Soc. India*.

ON THE SPOT PAINTING COMPETITION (February 13, 2015)

An on The Spot Painting Competition is also being organized under different categories (School children, UG & PG students and open for all), with a view to creating awareness about the orchids at grass root level, under the program. In case of school children, the entries shall be invited under further 3 sub-categories depending upon to the class groups for school children (1-4, 5-7, 8-12). The paintings will be adjudged by an expert committee and in each category, two prizes will also be given.

ORCHID SHOW (February 13-15, 2015)

An orchid show based on live plants, photographs and paintings has also been planned with a view to creating awareness and educating about the importance of genetic diversity of orchids. Many orchid species and hybrids shall be exhibited besides those that are botanically, medicinally and economically significant. Some of the highly esteemed institutes/organizations/commercial growers have confirmed their participation. We do hope that the wonderful show of orchid flowers and plants shall delight everyone, both participants and visitors.

On behalf of TOSI, and on my own behalf, I have the pleasure to invite you very cordially to participate in the conference and enrich its proceedings by contributing research paper in any of the listed themes of the conference. I am sure that despite your very busy schedule, it shall be possible for you to accept this invitation and confirm your participation by mailing the enclosed Registration Form.

ABOUT SHRI MATA VAISHNO DEVI UNIVERSITY (SMVDU), KAKRYAL, KATRA (J&K)

The Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University, commonly referred to as SMVD University, is a Central Funded University on an 470-acre (190 ha) campus located near Katra (J&K). It is situated near the Shrine of the Mata Vaishno Devi, after which it is named, and has witnessed remarkable growth. The university is fully residential and provides technical education in the field of Engineering, Science, Management, Philosophy and other subjects of contemporary importance, with all technical courses recognised by AICTE, CIC, COA. With the focus on higher learning & research, SMVDU has established itself in the league of eminent institutions of learning in the country. The university is situated on spectacular location – a plateau surrounded by mountains on three sides in the foothills of 'Trikuta' Range where the world famous shrine of Mata Vaishno Devi is located. It is a self-contained township with most facilities available in-house. The surrounding green hills and the perennial stream of Jhajjar in the East minimize the effects of hot and cold winds and produce a pollution free atmosphere on the campus. The average day temperature in summer is around 35°C, 4°C lesser than the surrounding areas of Jammu region and the maximum and minimum temperatures in winter are about 14°C and 5°C respectively.

Information for Visitors

SMVDU Campus is located 14 kms short of the holy town of Katra and about 40 kms from Jammu, which is extremely well connected by Road, Rail & Air. One can reach SMVDU campus by local or private transport from Jammu. The weather at the time of the Conference is a bit chilly with an average temperature of 10-16 °C.

Option 1: Taxi can be availed from Railway Station/Bus Stand/Airport directly to University Campus (Distance approximately 45 kms.)

Option 2: Bus can also be availed from Jammu Bus Stand/Railway Station plying to Udhampur/Katra but alight at Domel (Approx. 39 kms.). Mini Bus from Domel to University (Approx. 6 kms.)
